Eko Club Atlanta seeks to provide humanitarian assistance to the poor, the needy, and the underprivileged in our communities here in the metro Atlanta and in Lagos, Nigeria. Part of our mission is also to positively impact our institutions of higher learning and the health care sector/system in our community here (Atlanta) and in Lagos through our community projects geared towards these sectors.
